

## ADVANCED NAVIGATION INSTRUCTOR STANDARD

### **Prerequisites**

The candidate must:

1. Be a current CYA Advanced Cruising Instructor and CYA Coastal Navigation Instructor;
2. Have practical experience and training in radar operation and collision avoidance techniques and an advanced level on the water navigation skills;
4. Demonstrate characteristics and motivations worthy of being at CYA LTC/P Instructor;
5. Demonstrate a willingness to support the goals of the CYA LTC/P program;

Note: In special circumstances, applications will be considered when there is a demonstrated need for a Navigation Instructor (that is insufficient Instructors in a geographic area). Candidates who are not an Advanced Cruising or a Coastal Navigation Instructor but with strong teaching backgrounds or experience in other marine education systems and meet all other requirements may apply to the CYA LTC/P Committee.

### **Certification**

The candidate must:

1. Achieve a mark of 90% on the *CYA Advanced Navigation* examination within 2 hours;
2. Provide a course curriculum and lesson plans for a program leading to the CYA Advanced Navigation Standard;
3. Complete the application in the Training Division Policy Manual, Section III - Appendix E.

### **Certification Power**

Advanced Navigation Standard

Instructors/IEs must register annually prior to teaching or awarding CYA certifications.

An Instructor/IE Candidate should possess all prerequisites prior to enrolling in a clinic, and must complete all the requirements for certification within four months of the last day of the IDP in which the Instructor Candidate participated.

Recertification is required for all instructor/IE levels within 36 months of the first calendar yearend following the last day of an initial certification, recertification or IDP as authorized by the CYA LTC/P Committee.

Recertification is by application to the CYA as per Training Division Policy Manual or by attending an IDP to renew or upgrade Instructor/IE qualifications.
