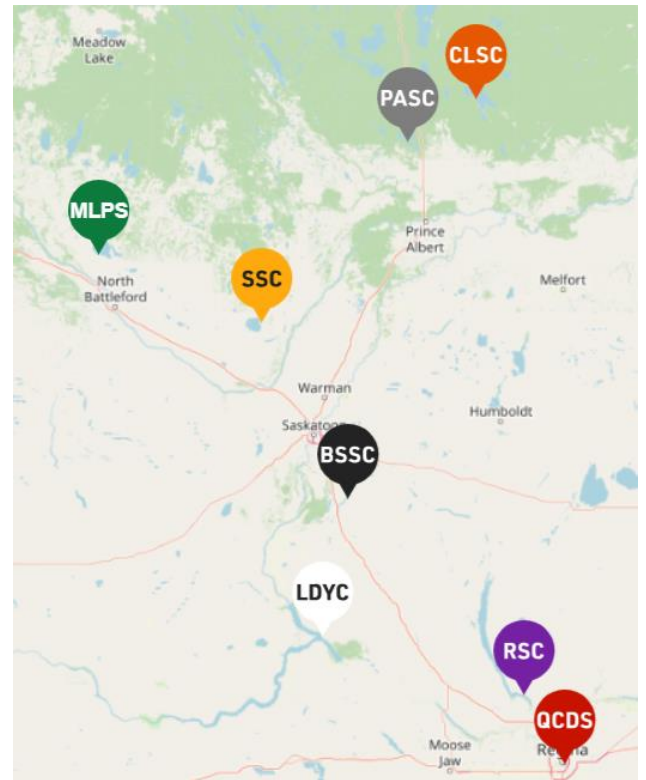

Head Sailing Instructor for Mobile Sailing School

The Head Sailing Instructor is responsible for leading the Mobile Sailing School, overseeing all logistics, managing instructors and assistants, and ensuring a safe and engaging learning environment. This role requires strong leadership, organizational, and communication skills. Candidates must be certified as a Sail Canada Level 1-2 Instructor, possess prior coaching experience, hold a valid first aid certificate, and be comfortable towing a trailer. The position also requires the ability to camp for the duration of each program session.



Sailing Instructor for Mobile Sailing School

The Sailing Instructor will assist the Head Instructor in delivering high-quality sailing instruction and ensuring the smooth operation of the Mobile Sailing School. This role requires strong teamwork, motivation, and communication skills. Candidates must hold Sail Canada Level 1-2 Instructor certification, have a valid first aid certificate, and be comfortable driving a motorboat. The ability to travel independently and camp for the duration of each session is essential.

Assistant Instructor for Mobile Sailing School

The Assistant Instructor supports the instructional team while gaining valuable experience in preparation for becoming a certified sailing instructor. This role is ideal for a skilled sailor looking to develop teaching abilities. Candidates must have strong sailing skills, including handling a double-handed boat solo and sailing in heavy winds. The ability to travel independently and camp in remote locations is required.
