



CANSail Instructor/Coach International Equivalency

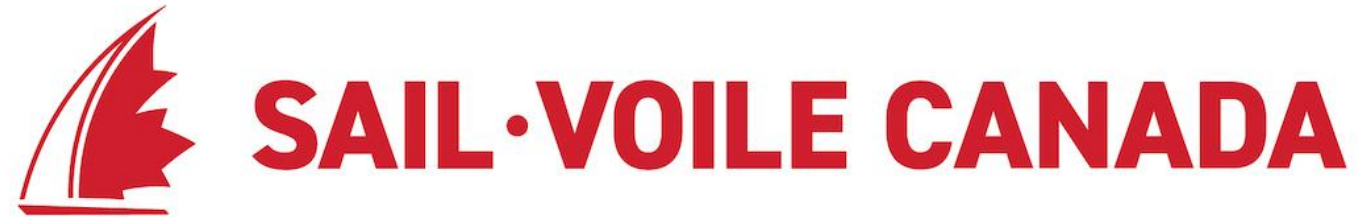
Sail Canada welcomes Instructors with qualifications from National Sailing Federation (NSF) to apply for CANSail Instructor Certification via our equivalency program.

To apply, please view the equivalency chart below, and complete the [CANSail Instructor Equivalency Application](#). To complete the application, please send copies of required documentation to programs@sailing.ca.

If the NSF from which you hold certifications is not listed, please complete the application and email all documentation that may be applicable to programs@sailing.ca, including an NSF reference or contact. Sail Canada continues to work with other NSFs to establish equivalency and may have a solution on hand already.

All applications will be subject to a \$100 CAD administration fee.

Notes for Applicants:

- Equivalency Applications are reviewed on a case by case basis and must be supported by copies of all relevant documentation.
- In all cases where certifications are granted, CANSail Instructors are required to meet and maintain prerequisite requirements.
- All CANSail Instructors are required to complete an Annual Instructor Registration with Sail Canada in order to be eligible to deliver training.
- Expired certifications will not be accepted as proof of equivalency.
